









Surviving the Highs and Lows

The 2000 Northstar football season started out with a BANG!!! The Northstars had a promising season outlook. The team returned many offensive players, including last years Co-MVP's Ben Pitz (half back) and Tanner Knecht (quarterback). The defense also looked very promising with many players returning and last years MVP Jon Mardian back to play his defensive end position.

The Northstars started off the season with a win against Faulkton. The Northstars suffered losses to both Hitchcock/Tulare and Ipswich in pre-conference action.

After these three games the 'Stars were 1-2 going into conference action. The Northstars first conference game was Homecoming against the Roslyn Vikings. The team played a very good game and won the first Homecoming game in 4 years. After the win the 'Stars went on a 3 game skid and lost to Northwestern, Doland/Conde, and Langford. The 'Stars struggled in offense and defense in the Northwestern and D/C game but came back strong in the Langford game which inspired a momentum change.

The team ended their 3 game skid by defeating the Warner Monarchs. Another bright spot in this game was that the 'Stars ended a 12 year losing streak at Warner. With this win the team was able to host a playoff game in Frederick for the first time since 1997.


The 'Stars came out pumped and executed well in this game but were trailing at half-time. The team rallied in the second half but let the Patriots score with 34 seconds left in the game to end the 'Stars season.

The Northstars offense was led by Ben Pitz with 528 yards on 101 carries for 6 touchdowns and 3 two-point conversions, second was Brett Riggs with 505 yards on 90 carries for 5 touchdowns and 3 twopoint conversions. Tanner Knecht led through the air with 363 yards passing. The defense was led by Adam Heinrich with 73 tackles and second was Jordan Torrence with 60 tackles. The Northstars return a lot of talent next year and look to be in the hunt for the conference championship.









Another Successful Year












Above left: Coach Nelson instructs the girls duing a time out. Above right: Becky and Chrissy play strong defense by hustling to the ball.
