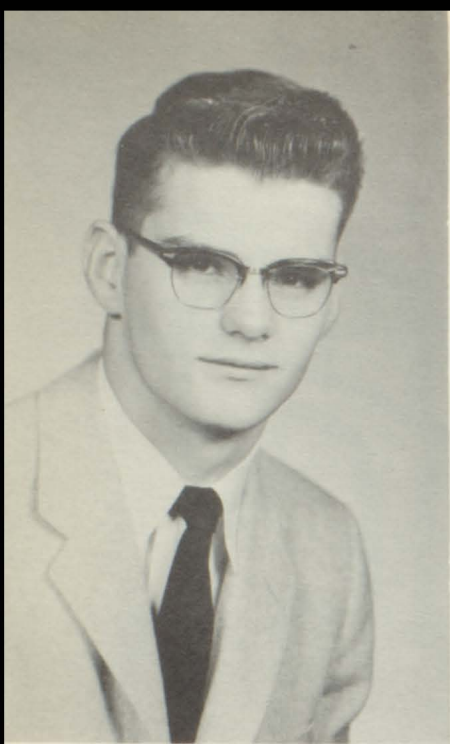




# SENIORS
