The Junior year gave us an increase of one, Sandy Keator, who moved here from Washington.

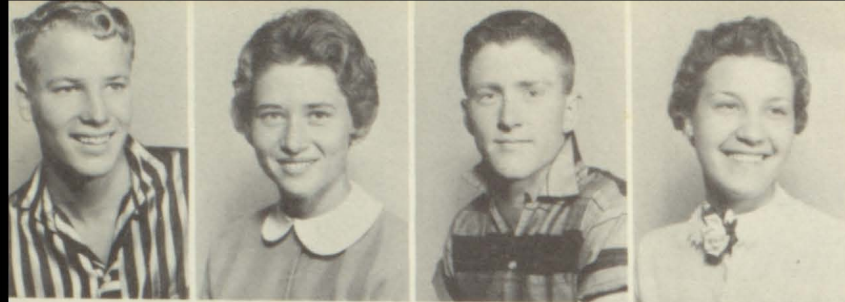
