The Vikings finished their football season very successfully, compiling a record of seven wins, one loss, and one tie. They also tied for Lake Region Conference Champions, sharing the title with Langford.

The Vikings were able to score 399 points compared to 112 points by their opponents, for an average of 44.4 points per game. They had a total of 3203 yards in 382 attempts for the season and also had an average of 99 yards passing per game.

The leading yard gainer for the season was Bruce Reisdorph with 1099 yards, followed by Keith Schlenker, Randy Jensen, and Terry Ochsner, with 705, 557, and 308 yards respectively.

Bruce Reisdorph and Terry Ochsner tied for the Viking scoring leadership with 72 points each. They were followed closely by Randy Jensen with 70 points and Keith Schlenker with 64 points. Others contributing to the Viking attack were Scott Post with 53 points, Aaron Rempher with 37, and Ray Voeller with 12 points.

Leading the Viking defense was Randy Jensen with 80 tackles. He was followed by Terry Ochsner with 73, Dave Golnitz with 72, Aaron Rempher with 71, Roger Glaser with 69, Scott Post with 63, Keith Schlenker with 57, Owen Bain with 56. Lee Podoll with 49, Ray Voeller with 42, Bruce Durkheim with 29, and Kevin Luoma with 28.
