Football Squad Takes Conference Title



The Vikings were able to score 399 points compared to 112 points by their opponents, for an average of 44.4 points per game. They had a total of 3203 yards in 382 attempts for the season and also had an average of 99 yards passing per game.












Kathy Cantwell was chosen to attend the Music Camp at the University of South Dakota at Vermillion. Kathy is sponsored by the Alpha Circle.




Students Attend Seminars

Students Receive Honors




